# NOBEL LEGACY FILM SERIES

*Working with the 13 inspiring Nobel Peace Laureates who make up PeaceJam's board, the PeaceJam Foundation is developing a series of films highlighting the cutting edge work being done by these Laureates as they fight to create a better future for all of humanity.*



The first film in this series, "Mayan Renaissance," featuring 1992 Nobel Peace Laureate Rigoberta Menchú Tum of Guatemala, was released in May of 2012.



"Children of the Light," featuring 1984 Nobel Peace Laureate Desmond Tutu of South Africa, will be released in December of 2013.



"Educating the Heart," featuring 1989 Nobel Peace Laureate The Dalai Lama of Tibet, will be released in December of 2014.

One feature length documentary film will be added to this series every year. Each unique and powerful film will be featured on PBS, in film festivals, on DVD, and online. In addition, the films will be made a permanent part of the PeaceJam Foundation's award-winning youth development curriculum that is implemented globally, inspiring youth to take action to address the most pressing issues of our time.

The first film in this series, "Mayan Renaissance," is a feature length film documenting the glory of the ancient Mayan civilization, the Spanish conquest in 1519, 500 years of brutal oppression, and the courageous fight of the Mayan people to reclaim their voice and determine their own future in Guatemala and throughout Central America. This beautiful and thought-provoking film shares their vision for the future, their call for a long-foretold renaissance of Mayan culture and wisdom, and their 100 year plan to lead humanity forward starting in the year 2012. The film stars 1992 Nobel Peace Laureate and Mayan leader Rigoberta Menchú Tum. All of the images, voices, expert commentary, and music in the film come directly from Central America, from the heart of the Mayan world.
